<b>Description:</b>	Curtin Mathematics Honours & Postgraduate Scholarships are awarded to students of exceptional research potential undertaking an Honours degree or a Postgraduate degree in the Department of Mathematics & Statistics in 2010.
<b>Applicable to:</b>	Current Students and Prospective Students
<b>Scholarship Type:</b>	Merit Based
<b>Year of Study:</b>	BSc (Honours), Masters and PhD
<b>Opening Date:</b>	For current students, applications must be submitted by January 30, 2010; for prospective students, applications may be submitted at any time during the year and must be submitted together with the application for admission.
<b>Maximum Number Awarded:</b>	4
<b>Value &amp; Duration</b>	Value : \$5,000 per year. Duration: one year for Honours, up to two years for Masters, up to three years for PhD.
<b>Tenable at:</b>	Curtin University of Technology to undertake a full time Honours, or Masters or Doctoral degree in the Department of Mathematics & Statistics.
<b>Eligibility:</b>	Applicants must be enrolled in or accepted to enrol in an Honours degree or a Postgraduate degree as a full-time student in 2010.  <b>Notes:</b> students who have been awarded another scholarship from Curtin University of Technology are not eligible for this scholarship.
